

Approved courses offered the Blue Water Middle College Academy

The Blue Water Middle College Academy (BWMCA) partners with seven high schools within St. Clair County. The BWMCA purchases seats for each enrolled student in classes taken at their respective home high schools. The classes offered by BWMCA partner districts are aligned to state standards, and credit from successfully completed classes is accepted by the BWMCA.

The BWMCA offers its students online courses through Michigan Virtual and Edgenuity. These courses are also aligned to state standards. Credit from successfully completing Michigan Virtual and/or Edgenuity courses is accepted by the BWMCA.

The BWMCA also offers its students courses via dual enrollment at St. Clair County Community College (SC4). Students can take any credit-bearing college course for which they qualify at SC4. BWMCA students may receive high school credit for successfully completed classes at SC4.

The Board approves all courses offered by its St. Clair County K-12 partner districts, Michigan Virtual, Edgenuity, and St. Clair County Community College.
